

The Coast Guard Chief Petty Officers Association (CPOA) was chartered on April 7, 1969.



The Coast Guard CPOA was formed to advance the interests of the United States Coast Guard Chief Petty Officer Corps, encouraging integrity and fidelity to the Service, and fellowship within our ranks. In 1991, the Coast Guard Enlisted Association was chartered by and for junior enlisted personnel, under the auspices of the CPOA, reinforcing the Association's motto – "In respect for those who have gone before us, and as a guide for those who follow".

The CPOA and the CGEA proudly serve Coast Guard and other military active duty and reserve members, Veterans, their families and their communities. Through our strong and united network of nearly 12,000 members, we work to advance the interests of our membership through community service, scholarships and fundraising, and by partnering with military and veterans' organizations, both locally and nationally.





A non-partisan, 501 (c) (19) not-for-profit Veterans Organization, the CPOA and CGEA serve as advocates on a variety of Military and Veterans issues. Representing our members on Capitol Hill as a partner of The Military Coalition, our Association promotes legislation to enhance the lives of past, present and future members of the U.S. Armed Forces and their families.

Our valued members are the lifeblood of our Association, and our success depends on volunteer leadership at the National, Chapter and Branch levels, and on the generosity of our sponsors and partners.

What CPOA has to offer to our membership

- The Captain Caliendo College Assistance Fund (CCCAF) to help enlisted family members with college costs. In 2026 we will raise our scholarship distribution from \$11,000/year to \$15,000/yr. These scholarships are only offered for eligible dependents of CPOA/CGEA Members.
- The Walter Gore Memorial Scholarship (WGMS) helps active-duty CPOA members who are pursuing higher education goals or technical certificates. Each year, CPOA allocates funds for two awards to be issued.
- A quarterly (in print) magazine, "THE CHIEF", to keep you informed on what other Chiefs are doing and provide a forum for presenting ideas.
- A monthly e-newsletter to keep you informed of relevant, important events that affect your service, benefits, and family matters.
- Over 100 Chapter and Branches established in the continental United States, Bahrain, Guam, Alaska, and Hawaii. Sharing with others, through association and mutual acquaintance, our professional abilities, loyalty, and devotion to God, leadership.
- Our affiliation and sponsorship of the Coast Guard Enlisted Association (CGEA), developing our reliefs and advocating for junior Coast Guard members – we have been there and understand the challenges of military service.
- Representation with other military and fraternal organizations through The Military Coalition (TMC), which allows us to stay abreast of legislation that will affect our members. Our Past National President is our Legislative Affairs Chair, and active member of TMC. Our previous Executive Director serves as the National Treasurer for TMC.

Coast Guard Disaster Response Coalition

The Coast Guard Chief Petty Officers Association has partnered with the <u>Coast Guard Foundation</u> to form the *Coast Guard Disaster Response Coalition* to facilitate dissemination of monetary relief to Coast Guard families impacted by natural disasters. This relationship, approved and supported by Coast Guard Leadership, relies on CPOA members to advocate for and validate the needs of those who need assistance when disasters affect Coast Guard members.

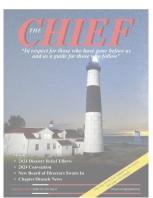
